2. Chief's Report

Chief Report given by Chief Rothenberger – see report for details.

The water tender is here but it does not run. It has a new motor with new heads. Sierra Fleet, the company who repaired it thus far submitted a bill for approximately \$15,000 which covers parts only and no labor. OHFPD will get an estimate to get it running. After the estimate is done, OHFPD will determine next steps.

The Type 6 went to commercial vehicle fire. It had easier accessibility than larger Type 1 and Type 2. It also got a got a good knock down on fire with 200 gallons.

We are currently on a 7-day OES storm preposition assignment. Engine 523 is staffed and available from Thursday, March 9, 2023 to Thursday, March 16. Several surrounding Fire Districts are also staffed on the OES assignment. Tim Fike is going to Calaveras County on OES request to be a liaison for the Calaveras County Emergency Operations Center in response to flooding.

OHFPD will not receive any monies from Proposition 64 as there are no commercial permitted cannabis operations in our district.

OHFPD has posted an open captain's position with a close date of April 15, 2023. Chief Rothenberger will update at the next board meeting. At that time, we may want to post an open engineer position.

OHFPD is in the process of getting on board with City of Grass Valley Fire Department reporting system to update OHFPD's system.

Nevada County Consolidated Fire District and OHFPD signed off on the Automatic Aid Agreement. As initiated by Chief Robitaille, NCCFD will provide a duty officer when Chief Rothenberger is not available. In this case, the ECC will automatically dispatch a NCCFD duty officer to any vehicle accident or structure fire.
