2. Chief's Report

Chief Report given by Chief Rothenberger – see report for details.

OHFPD assisted Nevada County Sheriff's Department and Habitat for Humanity in cleaning up the homeless encampment on the East Bennett property. There are now locked gates to prevent driving on to the property.

Captain Nelson and Chief Rothenberger held a Wildland Fire and Saw Class for Contra Costa County Fire with 29 attendees. Santa Cruz County Fire will be coming in February for the same class.

Halloween at Station 2 was very quiet again this year with only a few trick-or-treaters. Sierra Nevada ambulance services is having retention issues. There will be times when Advanced Life Support may be delayed due to qualifications of staffed drivers.

Fire season is coming to an end but permits are still required. Strongest El Nino predicted for this year.

Seasonal Firefighter Sullivan is leaving and his last day is Nov 30. The position is posted and there are no applications submitted yet.
